PASADENA, Calif. — Kaiser Permanente announced its 2024 Rose Parade® float theme, "Symphony of You." The theme represents the many ways Kaiser Permanente works together harmoniously to care for each of its members. The float celebrates life's milestones and how — like the coordinated, dynamic, and integrated notes of a song — Kaiser Permanente supports its members and the communities it serves.

This year, Kaiser Permanente's 18th annual float entry embodies the 2024 Rose Parade presented by Honda theme, "Celebrating a World of Music," by bringing everyone together through music. At the center of the float, a Kaiser Permanente member stands with outstretched arms, surrounded by photos depicting life moments and the caregivers who have helped along the way.

The Los Angeles Philharmonic will perform a special piece of music that conveys the emotion of an individual's journey, as diverse cultural groups from across Kaiser Permanente dance and walk alongside the float.

Leishman Trophy for the most beautiful float entry from a noncommercial sponsor (2014, 2012); Director's Trophy for most artistic merit in design and floral

presentation (2011, 2008, 2006); Extraordinaire Trophy for the "most spectacular" float longer than 55 feet (2010); Tournament Special Trophy for exceptional merit in multiple classifications (2009); and President's Trophy for most effective floral use and presentation (2007).
